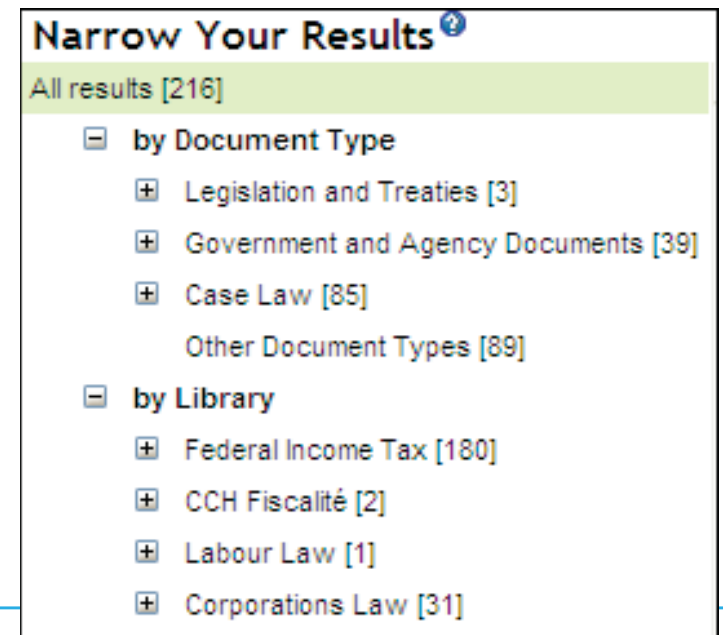
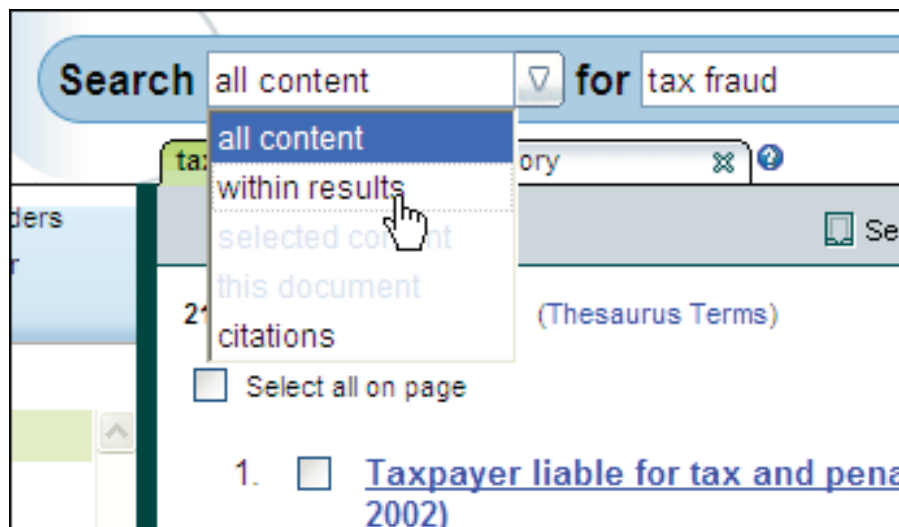

## [¶11-230] PREPAID PURCHASE CARDS

Prepaid purchase cards (which include gift cards, payroll cards, incentive cards, and cards designed for certain categories of spending) are similar to debit cards in that the cardholder must provide funds before the card may be used in payment. But unlike debit cards, which allow the cardholder to withdraw funds from a preexisting deposit account, a prepaid purchase card requires a separate funding arrangement.

The definition of "prepaid card" found at section 170 of Manitoba's *Consumer Protection Act* is typical: "In this Part, 'prepaid purchase card' means . . . an electronic card, written certificate or other voucher or device with a monetary value, that is issued or sold in exchange for the future purchase or delivery of goods or services, and includes a gift card and gift certificate". In fact, British Columbia, New Brunswick, and Saskatchewan have verbally identical definitions, while those of Ontario and Alberta are substantially identical.

The spread throughout Canada of these cards, particularly gift cards, has been phenomenal in the 2000s. Statistics Canada reported that "during the 2003 Christmas holiday season, 53% of large retailers had made the cards available". This trend has continued to come.

## [¶3400-200] ANALYSIS OF THE NATURE OF DERIVATIVES PRODUCTS

Ontario Securities Commission Rule [14-501](#) — *Definitions* defines a derivative as "an instrument, agreement or security, the market price, value or payment obligations of which is derived from, referenced to, or based on an underlying interest ..." where "underlying interest" is defined as "the security, commodity, financial instrument, currency, interest rate, foreign exchanges rate, economic indicator, index, basket, agreement or benchmark or any other financial reference, interest or variable, and, if applicable, the relationship between any of the foregoing, from, to or on which the market price, value, or any payment obligation of the derivative is derived, referenced, or based".

The *Derivatives Act* (Québec) defines "derivative" as "an option, a swap, a futures contract or any other contract or instrument whose market price, value, or delivery or payment obligations are derived from, referenced to or based on an underlying interest, or any other contract or instrument designated by regulation or considered equivalent to a derivative on the basis of criteria determined by regulation".

In each case the basic concept is that a derivative is a financial instrument whose value is derived from the value of an underlying interest.

Derivatives are divided into broad categories based on whether or not they trade on organized exchanges, the nature of the underlying interest they reference and the manner in which they are settled at maturity.

Exchange-traded derivatives include products such as commodity futures, options on commodity futures and exchange-traded options, which in Canada are traded on the Montreal Exchange, ICE Futures Canada (formerly the Winnipeg Commodity Exchange) and the Natural Gas Exchange.

Derivatives which are not traded on exchanges are commonly referred to as "over-the-counter" or "OTC" derivatives. OTC derivatives are private instruments the terms of which are negotiated by the parties to the instrument, rather than being standardized as with exchange-traded derivatives. OTC derivatives are vital elements for
